

## Measuring Instructions for Perfect Fit Blinds - Pleated, Honeycomb and Venetian

Please note: Our perfect fit blinds are only suitable for UPVC windows and doors with a rubber gasket holding the glass in place. When testing if your window is compatible, please use a butter knife to perform the test. The thickness of the knife will mimic the thickness of the bracket we use with this style.

### Checking Your Window is Suitable:



To ensure that your window is suitable, slide a butter knife into your rubber gasket and push it as far as it will go. To help the knife ease in, you can use washing up liquid or furniture polish.



Mark the distance the blade travels under the gasket.



Measure this distance, and if it is **at least 18mm**, your window beading is suitable for to hold the brackets.



**Top Tip:** Before measuring please ensure there is a clearance of at least 25mm between the perimeter of your glass pane from obstructions such as handles and air vents, to allow enough room for the perfect fit frame.

**Measuring Your Windows:**

Depth Gauge (TP487)



To start, measure the depth between the face of the frame and glass by using a depth gauge.

Alternatively, place something with a flat surface in the corner of your frame and use a metal tape measure to find the bead depth.

Providing this is anywhere between 18mm and 38mm, your window is suitable and you can start measuring.

Make a note of your bead depth as you will need this when ordering.



To find the perfect fit, measure the width of your window from rubber gasket/seal to rubber gasket/seal (eg. the visible glass).

Do this at three different points (top, middle and bottom) and note down the shortest distance to the nearest millimetre. This will be your width.



Repeat the process to find the drop of your window by measuring from rubber gasket/seal to rubber gasket/seal (visible glass) down the height of your window.

Do this across three different points (left, middle and right) and note down the shortest distance to the nearest millimetre. This will be your drop.



Decide on the colour and style you prefer and place your order.

It really is that simple!
